We are supportive of your recommended change for the CP in Chemistry Technician from CIP 40.0501 to CIP 41.0301. I missed keying the change in the information I sent to Mason.

I wanted to include the recommendations I sent Mason before the holidays. Below is what I sent him.

Attached is a list of the ATU LON questions you had with answers in GREEN. Below is a summary of the answers:

CP Sports Media – Withdraw proposal. Will present later as a New Program Proposal.
CP Cyber Resilience – CIP code 43.0303. Rationale: This CIP (43.0303) covers “cyber infrastructure from external threats...including...critical infrastructure policy, information security...security systems, and intelligence operations.” We believe this certificate most closely falls within this CIP.
CP Emergency Management – CIP code 43.0302
CP Global Security – CIP code 43.0399
CP Small UAS – CIP code 49.0109
GC Business Continuity – CIP code 43.0302
GC Leading in Crisis – Withdraw proposal.
GC Cyber Risk Management – CIP code 43.0302
AC Secondary Education – Withdraw proposal. DESE hasn’t approved yet.
BS Middle Level Science Option - MLED 3073 Diversity in the Classroom is missing from the list.
CP Training and Org Dev – CIP code 52.0213
BS Medical Laboratory Science – Last degrees will be awarded spring 2026. The program can be listed in phase-out.
BS Nuclear Medicine Technology – Last degrees will be awarded spring 2026. The program can be listed in phase-out.
BS Tourism and BS Tourism Therapeutic Recreation Emphasis – CIP code 52.0903
BS Environmental Science – Last degrees will be awarded spring 2026. The program can be listed in phase-out.
CP Chemistry Technician – CIP code 41.0301
CP Instrumental Analysis – Withdraw proposal.
GC Data Science – CIP code 30.7001. As for aligning our GC with the state initiative, we can (and will) look at moving in that direction in the future but may likely be constrained due to lack of resources to add, and teach, additional classes that full alignment may require.

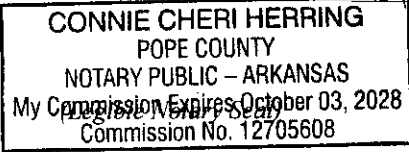

IMPORTANT

Where to file:

- State or district candidates/public servants file with the Secretary of State.
- Appointees to state boards/commissions file with the Secretary of State.
- County, township, and school district candidates/public servants file with the county clerk.
- Municipal candidates/public servants file with the city clerk or recorder, as the case may be.
- City attorneys file with the city clerk of the municipality in which they serve.
- District judges file with the Secretary of State.
- Members of regional boards or commissions file with the county clerk of the county in which they reside.

General Information:

- * The Statement of Financial Interest should be filed by January 31 of each year.
- * The filing covers the previous calendar year.
- * Candidates for elective office shall file the Statement of Financial Interest for the previous calendar year on the first Monday following the close of the period to file as a candidate for elective office unless already filed by January 31. In addition, if the party filing period ends before January 1 of the year of the general election, candidates for elective office shall file a Statement of Financial Interest for the previous calendar year by no later than January 31 of the year of the general election.
- * Agency heads, department directors, and division directors of state government shall file the Statement of Financial Interest within thirty (30) days of appointment or employment unless already filed by January 31.
- * Appointees to state boards or commissions shall file the Statement of Financial Interest within thirty (30) days after appointment unless already filed by January 31.
- * If a person is included in any category listed above for any part of a calendar year, that person shall file a Statement of Financial Interest covering that period of time regardless of whether they have left their office or position as of the date the statement is due.

Ark. Code Ann. § 21-8-403 provides that, upon conviction, any person who violates any provision of subchapter 4, 6, 7, or 8 of chapter 8, Title 21 of the Arkansas Code is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. The culpable mental state required shall be a purposeful violation.
